



## Case Study OLIVE BRANCH RESTAURANT

### Requirement

The Olive Branch, a nationally renowned country pub in Clipsham, Rutland, wanted to be able to screen their kitchen door and window against insects in compliance with the Food Standards Agency's (FSA) hygiene regulations, which require that fly screens be easily removable for cleaning.

### Product

PressFit screens were fitted to the door and window as they offer excellent ventilation and insect protection. The screens attach to the window or door frame using self-adhesive tape so they can easily be removed for cleaning before being refitted with new tape. The cassette ensures that no insects can get in around the edges of the mesh and the retractable design protects the mesh from wear-and-tear when not in use – ideal for a busy commercial kitchen.
